Prof. Pulcini is a member of ESGAP executive committee (ESCMID Study Group for Antibiotic Policies), she is also vice-president of the international association WAAAR (World Alliance Against Antibiotic Resistance) and member of the French National Antibiotic Plan (Ministry of Health). She has been doing research studies on the antibiotic stewardship topic for ten years and she has published more than 100 articles in peer-reviewed journals.

#### Eligibility Requirements

The research fellow needs to have validated **at least a Master 2 diploma** (in Public Health if possible).

**It is also possible to register within a PhD in Public Health**; the research fellow needs then to meet the minimum eligibility requirements for a 3-year PhD programme, notably having validated his/her Master 2 diploma (in Public Health).

#### Specialist Status

Applicants must have started or completed residency training in either Infectious Diseases [DESC Pathologies Infectieuses et Tropicales] or another specialty, namely Public Health [DES Santé Publique] or general practice [DES Médecine Générale], all with a special interest in antibiotic stewardship.

**Funding** : 1 600 euros/month (net salary).

#### Minimum required documentation

An up-to-date curriculum vitae, to include contact information, DOB, country of birth, citizenship, **proficiency in English** (TOEFL score...), education and medical training, employment history, publications, past research experience... must be sent to Prof. Pulcini ([celine.pulcini@univ-lorraine.fr](mailto:celine.pulcini@univ-lorraine.fr)), as well as 2 reference letters.

#### Application Deadlines

Fellowship start date is scheduled for 1st October 2015. Applications must be submitted before the **end of March 2015**.
